Paper

Energy and water

- All employees home-based.
- We will seek to reduce the amount of energy used as much as possible.
- Lights and electrical equipment will be switched off when not in use.
- Heating will be adjusted with energy consumption in mind.
- The energy consumption and efficiency of new products will be taken into account when purchasing.
- We will avoid water wastage wherever possible.

Office supplies

- We will evaluate if the need can be met in another way.
- We will evaluate the environmental impact of any new products we intend to purchase.
- We will favour more environmentally friendly and efficient products wherever possible.
- We will reuse and recycle everything we are able to.

Computer equipment/Hosting

- Use Carbon Neutral server hosting
- All computers use Energy Star/auto-shutdown
- All equipment recycled via EasyWeee or PCB (local computer recycling company)

Transportation

- We will promote the use of travel alternatives such as e-mail or video/phone conferencing.
- We will favour 'green' vehicles and maintain them rigorously to ensure ongoing efficiency.

Maintenance, cleaning and waste management

- We will only use licensed and appropriate organisations to dispose of waste.
